

Out of Hours GP Service relocation

On Tuesday 8 August 2017 the Cambridge Out of Hours (OOH) GP service will move from Chesterton Medical Centre to the Urgent Treatment Centre at Addenbrooke's Hospital.

How does the Out Of Hours GP service work?

The Cambridge Out of Hours (OOH) GP service will continue to provide advice, information and treatment for patients who become unwell when their own GP surgery is closed. It is available between 6.30pm to 8.00am on weekdays and 24 hours at weekends and on bank holidays.

The Out Of Hours GP service does not offer walk-in appointments. **To contact the service you will need to call NHS 111.**

The NHS 111 team will assess your condition over the phone and if they think you need to be seen by a health professional, they will refer you to the Out of Hours GP service. You will then be offered either:

- A telephone consultation with a doctor or nurse practitioner
- A face to face appointment at the Urgent Treatment Centre at Addenbrooke's Hospital to see a doctor or nurse practitioner

or

- A home visit from one of our doctors or nurse practitioners.

NHS 111 is available 24 hours day, 365 days a year and is free to call from mobile phones and landlines.
