

Burwell Surgery Policy Update

Infection Protection and Control (IPC) guidance has continued to evolve throughout the pandemic and we have reached the point where we can make some changes in light of the local COVID-19 infection rates.

As from Wednesday 15th June, we will be transitioning back towards our pre-pandemic policies.

In summary:

- Patients can be accompanied to appointments if they wish
- Clinical staff will continue to wear facemasks if patients present with respiratory symptoms and they suspect COVID19
- If you are immunosuppressed or it is your personal preference for our Clinical staff to wear a facemask, please let one of our reception team know on arrival
- Health and care staff in general do not need to wear face masks in non-clinical areas e.g. offices unless personal preference
- Patients with respiratory symptoms should wear a facemask or covering if tolerated or offered one on arrival
- Other patients are not required to wear a facemask unless personal preference
- People accompanying patients not routinely required to wear a face mask unless personal preference
